

Publication of documents on the Anti-Dumping Review Panel website

Under section 269ZZX(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* (Act), the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) is required to maintain a public record containing specified documents for certain reviews conducted under Division 9 of the Act. The Review Panel exceeds this requirement by publishing other documents that inform interested parties on the progress of reviews. The table below provides an overview of the documents that the Review Panel will usually publish on the website, subject to claims of confidentiality.

NOTE:

Depending on the type and circumstances of each review some or all of the above documents may be published in regard to the review on the ADRP website.

Documents that contain information that the interested party claims is confidential must be accompanied with a summary of that confidential information for the purposes of section 269ZZY of the Act. Summaries for the purposes of section 269ZZY of the Act usually takes the form of a "public version" or "non-confidential" version.

On occasion the ADRP Secretariat communicates with the Anti-Dumping Commission on administrative matters. These communications are not published.
