



Publication of documents on the Anti-Dumping Review Panel website

Under section 269ZZX(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* (Act), the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) is required to maintain a public record containing specified documents for certain reviews conducted under Division 9 of the Act. The Review Panel exceeds this requirement by publishing other documents that inform interested parties on the progress of reviews. The table below provides an overview of the documents that the Review Panel will usually publish on the website, subject to claims of confidentiality.

Document	Description of document
Public Notice of Intention to Conduct a Review (Initiation Notice)	Published under s 269ZZI(1) or s 269ZZRC(3)
Application(s) for review	The application made by an interested party to the ADRP: required to be published under s 269ZZX(1)(a)(i)
Notice requesting further information from applicant	Notice made under s 269ZZG(1)
Further information from applicant in response to notice made under s 269ZZG(1)	Further information provided by the applicant(s) to the ADRP in response to a notice made under s 269ZZG(1) is required to be published under s 296ZZX(1)(a)(ii)
Submission(s) received by the Review Panel	For a review under Subdivision B, submissions received under s 269ZZJ within the period of 30 days referenced in that section: required to be published under s 269ZZX(1)(a)(iii)
Summary of further information obtained at a conference	A summary of further information obtained at a conference held under s 269ZZHA or s 269ZZRA: required to be published under s 269ZZX(1)(a)(iv)
Request for Reinvestigation	A request for reinvestigation made by the Review Panel under s 269ZZL(1) to the Commissioner of the ADC
Request to Commissioner of the ADC for further information	A request for further information made by the Review Panel under s 269ZZRB(1)
Request for extension of time to reinvestigate	A request from the Commissioner of the ADC to extend the time to provide a reinvestigation
Request for documents from the ADC	On initiation of a review the ADRP requests information that was before the Commissioner of the ADC in relation to the Reviewable Decision
ADRP response to request for extension of time for	The Review Panel's response to the Commissioner of the ADC request for an extension to provide the results of the reinvestigation

Reinvestigation – Letter from ADRP	
Public Notice advising of the decision of the Parliamentary Secretary to extend the time to decide.	Minister must give notice of the longer period on the Review Panel’s website under s 269ZZM(1B)
Public Notice of decision of the Parliamentary Secretary	Decision of the Minister under s 269ZZM(1). Minister must give notice of his or her decision on the Review Panel’s website under s 269ZZM(4)
ADRP Report	Report of the Review Panel to the Minister on the application for review under s 269ZZK
ADC Reinvestigation Report	A report in relation to a request by the Review Panel to the Commissioner of the ADC to reinvestigate a specific finding or findings that formed the basis of the reviewable decision: s 269ZZL
Decision of the ADRP in a Termination review under s 269ZZT	The Review Panel must publish its decision of a review of a termination decision: s 269ZZT(6)

NOTE:

Depending on the type and circumstances of each review some or all of the above documents may be published in regard to the review on the ADRP website.

Documents that contain information that the interested party claims is confidential must be accompanied with a summary of that confidential information for the purposes of section 269ZZY of the Act. Summaries for the purposes of section 269ZZY of the Act usually takes the form of a “public version” or “non-confidential” version.

On occasion the ADRP Secretariat communicates with the Anti-Dumping Commission on administrative matters. These communications are not published.
